Ms. Bridget Lane presented the Economic Development Progress Report to the Village Council. Bridget stated the goal is to grow the pie, not take businesses away from other towns.

It was moved by Commissioner Mannix and seconded by Commissioner Byrnes that the Ordinance amending Title 3, entitled "Business and License Regulations," by adding Chapter 15, entitled "Video Gaming," and amending Chapter 3, entitled "Liquor Control," and amending Chapter 2, entitled "General Offenses," of Title 5, entitled "Police and Public Safety," of the municipal code of the Village of Forest Park be adopted. It was discussed that this ordinance does not usurp the public's right to petition for a referendum question on the ballot in the spring. Further, any class "V" supplemental liquor licenses will have to come before the Village Council as the current allowable number of licenses in this ordinance is zero. Last, the Mayor notified the Council that there are currently 42 businesses that would be eligible to apply for the supplemental Class "V" license.
