

## **5-2-11: FIRES; OPEN BURNING:**

A. It shall be unlawful to build or light any fire on any public street, sidewalk, pavement or other public place, or so as to endanger any building or structure within the village.

B. Use of outdoor barbecue grills, manufactured outdoor fireplaces, campfires, fire containers or other similar devices are prohibited on any porch, balcony or deck with the following exceptions:

1. LP-gas or natural gas fueled appliances shall be allowed on freestanding or affixed decks in single-family residences where the following clearances from the appliances are observed: thirty six inches (36") on the sides and rear and forty eight inches (48") in front in residential areas; no appliance of any kind shall be allowed on any deck with overhanging structures such as roofs, balconies, trellises, etc.

2. LP-gas or natural gas fueled LP-gas or natural gas fueled appliances shall be allowed on affixed decks in multiple-family residences (not to exceed 3 dwelling units), provided the above clearances are observed and the required means of ingress and egress is not obstructed.

C. Permits are required for the installation of outdoor natural gas fueled appliances.

D. The use of manufactured open fireplaces, campfires, fire containers or other similar devices is prohibited on any porch, balcony or deck.

1. Use of such manufactured open fireplaces, campfires or other similar devices shall be permitted in residential areas provided the following clearances are observed: fifteen feet (15') from any combustible structure.

2. Only charcoal and/or wood may be used in manufactured fireplaces, campfires, fire containers or other similar devices.

3. A means of extinguishment must be present during the use of manufactured fireplaces, campfires, fire containers or other similar devices such as a fire extinguisher or a garden hose connected to a reliable water source.

4. A metal lid must be available for covering the container when not in use.

5. Open fireplaces, campfires, fire containers or other similar devices must be attended by an adult at all times when they are in use.

E. Smoke produced by barbecue grills and/or open fireplaces, campfires, fire containers or other similar devices must not be a nuisance to any neighbor. (Ord. O-32-02, 6-10-2002)
